
Operating Budget: December, 2022




Cash Position: December 2022




Operating Budget: YTD, October 2023


Parish Work Days

- Over 100 volunteers working 3 hours or more




Cleaning & sealing of Atkinson

Solar PV System





- Setting 2024 Goal for 200 pledges


Fundraising Goal

- Setting 2024 Goal for \$850,000

Setting attainable goals

- Average 2023 Pledge was \$4,516
- Median 2023 Pledge was \$2,760
 - 70% of pledges were below \$4,516
- Forward focus on increasing number of pledging members, high was 262 in 2016
